



## **UAV Pro, Inc. Export Policy**

UAV Pro, Inc.'s staff and management are fully committed to maintaining compliance with all applicable export regulations and will take responsibility for obtaining proper export licensing prior to shipping our products/data to international destinations/end users. We are also fully committed to maintaining compliance with laws and regulations governing the export of its products and technical data. Each employee must be dedicated to ensure compliance.

Similarly, UAV Pro, Inc.'s domestic customers have the responsibility for being aware of any and all applicable regulations pertaining to the lawful export of UAV Pro, Inc.'s products/data that they may contemplate shipping to any international destination/end-user. To that end we have adopted the following policy:

Under no circumstances shall the management and or personnel of UAV Pro, Inc. sell or ship or divulge technical data contrary to U.S. Export Laws or shall these laws be compromised for personal gain. Neither sales nor shipments or the release of technical data are to be made to any individual or firm appearing on the Denied Persons Lists or to any firms owned by or associated with the individuals of firms therein listed. No orders or shipments are to be made to any country subject to economic or trade sanctions imposed by the Office of Foreign Asset Control (OFAC), unless otherwise authorized by U.S. law. Regulations are in effect that place emphasis on the end-use and the end-user of exported items and technical data. In particular, no transaction can be made when dealing with individuals, companies and countries involved with the proliferation of nuclear missile and chemical/biological related processes and/or weapons without a license from the Department of State or the Department of Commerce.

Violations or possible violations to any General Prohibition of Export Laws and Regulations that becomes known to any UAV Pro, Inc. employee must be immediately reported to the president of UAV Pro, Inc.
